HELPFUL TIPS & REMINDERS

Stay Cool & Hydrated

- Drink plenty of water
- Wear light-colored, breathable clothing and sunscreen.
- Take breaks in the shade or in your car's AC between stops when needed.

Your Wellbeing Matters

- Know your limits. If you're feeling overheated, tired, or unwell, let us know.
- Reach out for help if a route feels too long in the heat — we're here to support you!

Check in on Seniors' Comfort

- Ask clients if they're keeping cool some may hesitate to use fans or AC to save money.
- Look out for signs of heat stress (e.g., confusion, fatigue, or dizziness).
- Report any concerns to the Berks Encore office immediately.
